OFFICIAL PROCEEDINGS OF THE TERREBONNE ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY BOARD MEETING TUESDAY, JULY 11, 2023

Vice-President Jason Underwood called the meeting to order at 12:00 p.m. The prayer and Pledge of Allegiance were led by Ms. Tammy Haydel. The meeting was held at the Government Tower Administrative Conference Room, 8026 Main Street, in Houma.

Members recorded as present were: Mr. Jason Underwood, Mr. Nicholas Hebert, Mr. Robert Barthel, Mr. Michael Lewis, Mr. Gary Williams, Sr., Mr. James "JJ" Buquet, III, and Mr. Joe Boudreaux, II; recorded as absent were: Dr. Michael Garcia and Mr. C.J. Domangue. Also present were: Mr. Cohen Guidry, TEDA's CEO and Ms. Tammy Haydel, TEDA's Executive Group Assistant.

Mr. Underwood made three calls for public wishing to address the committee with no response.

Mr. Hebert motioned to approve the June 13, 2023 TEDA Regular Board Meeting Minutes as submitted, seconded by Mr. Barthel. The motion passed unanimously.

Mr. Hebert presented the June financial reports. Financials are in line and balanced. There were annual commercial insurance expenditures. Reconciliations are in order. Mr. Barthel motioned to approve the June financial reports as submitted, seconded by Mr. Buquet. The motion passed unanimously.

Mr. Guidry presented the Board with the HTV - TEDA Time Renewal Contract. The term is for the period of 9/15/23 – 9/14/24. Mr. Guidry presented the Board with Resolution 23-003 in support of the concept of an oyster park in the vicinity of Montegut. It would provide storm protection while helping to expand economic opportunities in Terrebonne Parish through growth of its oyster industry.
