Legislation changed ERCs and 1099-K filings

The IRS has published information regarding changes enacted in the One Big, Beautiful Bill Act (OBBBA) as it relates to employee-retention tax credits (ERCs) and requirements for filing 1099-Ks.

The legislation prevents the IRS from allowing or refunding ERCs after July 4, 2025 for the third and fourth quarters of 2021 -- if those claims were filed after Jan. 31, 2024. It does not rescind credits granted after Jan. 31, 2024 if they were processed before July 4, 2025. Claims that are disallowed will receive letters to that effect; there is an appeals process. Also, the IRS has published information regarding the dollar threshold for filing the Form 1099-K. The OBBBA retroactively reinstates the reporting threshold to reportable payment transactions to a payee exceed \$20,000 and the number of transactions exceed 200.
