Bollinger Shipyards lands contract... Work on the four Arctic Support Cutter ships, for which Bollinger recently signed a contract with the U.S. Coast Guard, will be based at its Houma yard, supported by the company's other facilities across the Gulf Coast. It's the fifth class of cutter built by Bollinger for the Coast Guard.

Fletcher receives \$1.36 million grant... First in Louisiana... Cardiovascular Institute of the South and Terrebonne General Health System are first in Louisiana to use the AngioSafe Santreva - ATK Endovascular Revascularization Catheter to help restore blood flow in patients with peripheral artery disease. It's a wire-free catheter which can prepare blocked or narrow arteries in a single step for more efficient and speedier treatment.

Health partnership gets top honors in state... Healthgrades has named Terrebonne General Health System, in partnership with Cardiovascular Institute of the South, one of America's 100 Best Hospitals for Coronary Intervention -- the only hospital in Louisiana to receive the honor. The hospital was also rated five stars for coronary intervention procedures, receiving four Specialty Excellence Awards. This puts the hospital among the top 5% of U.S. hospitals for coronary intervention and in the top 10% two years in a row.
